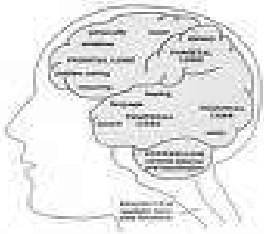


What is the Brain Injury Association of Florida?

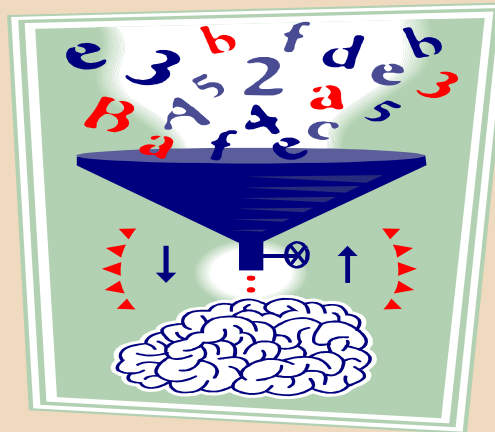

What is the Transition to Work Program?

Criteria for Program:

- Ages 18 or older
- Interested in obtaining long-term employment
- Diagnosed with a traumatic brain injury
- At least 2 years post-injury



This program is intended to assist consumers with a successful transition into the vocational realm. It is designed to equip you with the tools for adjustment related to seeking and maintaining employment.
