Items are listed in the order they should be put on. Performer must have assistance in dressing.

Padded undergarment/fake shoulders & chest (1)  
(Large side in front)

Zippered fur suit with tail (1)  
(Be careful - zipper can get caught in fur)

One-piece polyester t-shirt & pants (1)  
(Fur tail goes in slot in pants)

Brown belt (1)

Reebok tennis shoes, size 15 (2)  
(Use cotton balls or other stuffing to fill shoes)

Fur gloves (2)

Helmutt head (1)

Note: You may need to purchase cotton balls or other stuffing for shoes and alcohol wipes or alcohol for cleaning.

## **HELMUTT® COSTUME MAINTENANCE AND CARE**

The costume may be washed in cold water in a machine set on the gentle cycle.  
Hang the costume on a clothes hanger to air-dry,

**Never put the fur costume in a clothes dryer - the heat of the dryer will kink the fibers of the suit and the fibers will clog and damage the dryer.**

The fur costume may be gently combed with a wide toothed doggy comb.

To clean the inside of the costume head, wipe with alcohol towels or spray with alcohol and wipe out. You may also spray the inside of the fur suit with alcohol immediately after use and hang to dry. Do not try to ship bottles of alcohol with the costume. Do not ship a wet costume.

Hang and air-dry after use and before packing for shipping. Never carry or store the costume in a plastic garbage bag.

You may touch up eyes and other colored areas with magic marker. You may re-stitch where necessary such as tails and seams.

Any unglued parts can be re-attached with a hot-glue gun.

Please use care when repacking the costume and parts to ensure they arrive in good condition.
